INSTRUCTION FOR THE CANDIDATES FOR THE ONLINE WRITTEN TEST

- (1) The examination hall/room shall be opened 45 minutes before the scheduled time for the commencement of the examination (i.e. March 10, 2019 "SUNDAY"). No candidate shall be permitted to enter the examination hall/ room after 10:45 am.
- (2) Enter the examination hall 20 minutes before the schedule commencement of the examination.
- (3) Candidates without an Admit Card shall not be allowed to sit in the examination by the Centre Superintendents;
- (4) Admission will be granted on verification of identity of the candidate based on acceptable photo-id proof comprising any one of the following documents (in original) only: Aadhar Card, PAN Card, Voter's Id Card, Passport or Driving License;
- (5) Candidates not possessing the prescribed photo-id proof, shall not be allowed to sit for the online written test;
- (6) Mobile Phones, IT Gadgets, Calculators, Digital watch, Bluetooth Device, Tab or any other electronic devices shall not be allowed in Examination Hall; Candidates are found using or in possession of the above inside the Examination Hall, shall be summarily disqualified;
- (7) Candidates shall be advised not to bring any valuables/ costly items and bags to the Examination Halls, as safe keeping of the same cannot be assured. SAMS/ Examination Centre will not be responsible for any loss in this regard;
- (8) The question paper will be in two languages, English and Hindi. Candidate must select language option at the beginning of the test.
- (9) There is no negative mark for incorrect answers.
- (10) Candidates should carefully read and follow the instructions that appear on the screen at the start of the examination.
- (11) A blank A4 size paper along with a pencil shall be provided at the centre and the candidates may do any calculations if required, on the blank sheet provided. Candidate must ensure the submission of A4 Sheet and Pencil to the invigilator at the end of the examination.
- (12) Candidates shall not be allowed to leave their seats before the conclusion of the examination time.

Note:

In case of online written test is cancelled due to any glitches, system failure or any other unforeseen circumstances, a reserved date has been provisioned and test shall be conducted with different question paper on such centre on (March 12, 2019), all the terms and conditions would remain the same.
