

INSTRUCTIONS AND GUIDELINES TO BE FOLLOWED BY
SPECIALISTS WISHING TO BID FOR SERVICE LOCATION WITH
NATIONAL HEALTH MISSION, UTTAR PRADESH

Please carefully read and follow the instructions and guidelines below for applying for service locations for **Anesthetist/ Gynecologist (Maternal Health) / Pediatricians (PICU & SNCU)**:

- (1) Eligible bidders wishing to bid for the service locations need to register themselves online. Registration shall require inputting of requisite personal, educational and experience details, and uploading of all prescribed supporting;
- (2) Bidders shall be allowed to apply and bid for a maximum of 10 service locations during each 'Round of Solicitation of Proposal and Bids for Service location' for Specialist Doctors, which shall be open till 30th (in case of February 28th/29th) of each month;
- (3) Proposals uploaded by bidders shall be editable till the 30th (in case of February 28th/29th) of each month;
- (4) Bidders can change the quotes until the last day of the solicitation cycle;
- (5) The lowest bidder shall be offered the service location;
- (6) On 30th of each month (in case of February 28th/29th) bidding cycle shall be concluded for the particular round, next round of bidding cycle shall start on 1st of every month with the list of services locations where no bids were received and/or new services locations if it arises.
[Note: New service location can be added amid of the cycle, also service locations where bids are soliciting can be withdrawn without any prior notice].
- (7) Indicative Performance Based Rewards (PBRs) for respective service locations shall only be payable on the achievement of desired milestones. Please refer to the PBRs for Anaesthetist/ Gynaecologist/ Pediatricians uploaded on **SAMS** website along with deliverables;
- (8) Proposals submitted by bidders shall be considered eligible only if they fulfill eligibility criteria as per the SOWs of the **Anesthetist/ Gynecologist (Maternal Health)/ Pediatricians (PICU & SNCU)**.
- (9) It is mandatory for each bidder to fill the complete online form for further consideration;
- (10) Selected bidders shall be offered a one-year renewable service agreement with NHM, U.P.;
- (11) A pool of waitlisted candidates shall be prepared with a ratio of 1:5;
- (12) In case of a tie between the two bidders in terms of their quotes, we will offer the service location on the priority criteria in the descending order:
 - (a) Degree (preference shall be given over Diploma)
 - (b) Number of years of Experience

In case, if the lowest bidders could still not be sorted, we shall try to explore with all the bidders with adjacent facilities/ district with the same quote.

- (13) The age bracket for the bidders shall be 21 to 65 years;
- (14) Any bid can be cancelled at any point of time without assigning any reason.
- (15) Any Specialists selected and joined under the earlier rounds of bidding process or ongoing results awaited shall not be eligible for participation in the bidding process. However, specialists who have left the bidding model can bid again.
