INSTRUCTION & GUIDELINE FOR THE CANDIDATES FOR THE WRITTEN TEST

WRITTEN TEST SYLLABUS:

- (a) Midwifery and Obstetrical Nursing;
- (b) Community Health Nursing;
- (c) Child Health Nursing;
- (d) Medical Surgical Nursing;
- (e) Pathology;
- (f) Pharmacology;
- (g) Nutrition;
- (h) First Aid;
- (i) Paediatric Nursing;
- (j) Administration and Ward Management

RESULT AND MERIT LIST:

Minimum qualifying marks for the written test shall be as follows:

- (a) 33% for Un-Reserved categories;
- (b) 30% for OBC;
- (c) 24% for SC, ST

In case of a tie between the two candidates in terms of their marks, preference shall be given to:

- (i) Oldest candidate, even then if tie persist;
- (ii) Candidate name in ascending order shall be considered

INSTRUCTION & GUIDELINES:

(1) The examination hall/room shall be opened 45 minutes before the scheduled time for the commencement of the examination (i.e. **1:15 PM on June 16, 2019 "SUNDAY"**). Candidates reaching late by more than 20 minutes shall not be admitted to the examination

centres. The question paper shall comprise of 100 QBs and time duration for a sitting shall be 2 hours as mentioned above in the table. Note: Entry of candidates shall start in the examination hall/room at 1:15 pm for the examination.

(2) Candidates without an Admit Card and accompanied by Government recognized ID (Online Admit Card could be downloaded by the candidates from www.sams.co.in by submitting their Application No.) shall not be allowed to sit in the examination by the Centre Superintendents.

(3) A seat marked with roll numbers (Roll No. shall be provided in the Admit Card) shall be allotted to each candidate.

(4) The candidates must read instructions carefully imprinted on the backside of OMR Sheets and check that the Test Booklet & OMR Sheets provided to him/her is not defective and if so, may secure another copy from the Invigilator instead of the first one. The Test Booklet should be checked with reference to, Question Set, the serial number of the questions and code number before starting your response to the questions.

(5) The question paper will be provided in two languages, English and Hindi. In case of any discrepancy in the question paper, the English version will be considered final.

(6) The candidates must mark their responses in the provided OMR sheet, against the same serial no. of question which they are attempting from the Test booklet (e.g. Question:1 response in OMR sheet S.No.1)

(7) There is no negative mark for incorrect answers.

(8) No candidate shall be allowed to leave the examination hall/room before 4:00 pm.

(9) Mobile Phones, IT Gadgets, Calculators, Digital watch, Bluetooth Device, Tab or any other electronic devices shall not be allowed in Examination Hall; Candidates found using or in possession of the above inside the Examination Hall, shall be summarily disqualified;

(10) Candidates are advised not to bring any valuables/ costly items and bags to the Examination Halls, as safe keeping of the same cannot be assured. NHM, U.P/SAMS/ Examination Centre will not be responsible for any loss in this regard;

(11) No candidate should be permitted to go to the toilet during the last 20 minutes of the examination.

(12) Smoking and taking tea/ refreshment etc., by the candidates in the examination hall/room is strictly prohibited.

(13) Candidates need to return the test question booklet and Original OMR Sheet and one carbon copy of OMR Sheet (NHM, U.P/Client copy) to the invigilators at the end of the examination compulsorily and these must not be carried out with the candidates outside the Examination Hall. However, Candidates can leave the examination hall along with their carbon Copy of OMR Sheet after completion of the examination.
