3. The appointment will be purely on contractual basis for a period of the one-year, renewable subject to Government of India approval and satisfactory performance. Any claim for absorption in the regular position shall not be entertained in the future.
4. Mission Director, National Health Mission Madhya Pradesh, will have the right to suspend/cancel any application / entire process without giving any reason.
5. If at any stage of recruitment, it is found that the candidate does not fulfill the eligibility criteria and/or that she/ he has furnished incorrect/false information/certificate/documents or has suppressed any material fact(s), his/her candidature will stand cancelled. The decision of the NHM, MP in any matter relating to the recruitment at any stage of the recruitment process will be final and binding upon the candidates.
6. All requisite scanned documents/ testimonial/ certificates or any other documents

substantiating the claims made in the online form has to be uploaded in the online forms. Any candidate unable to provide any of the requisite documents shall be liable for the disqualification.

7. Original Documents of the candidate shall be validated at the time of joining of the candidates by the NHM officials.
8. Selected candidate needs to submit a medical certificate which shall be validated by the District Medical Board before the joining of the candidate.

**JOB DESCRIPTION****Contractual District Microbiologist (District/Lab)****Roles and Responsibilities:**

- (1) Facilitate capacity building of laboratory technicians (LT) by periodically assessing the training needs.
- (2) Perform all laboratory investigations of diseases of Public Health importance with special reference to diseases under IDSP.
- (3) Guide technicians for laboratory investigations of diseases of Public Health importance with special reference to diseases under IDSP.
- (4) Ensure implementation of Standard Operating Procedures (SOP) for laboratory techniques developed by IDSP
- (5) Ensure implementation of guidelines for Biomedical Waste Management based on existing rules.
- (6) Prepare and submit monthly status report of DPHL on laboratory tests carried out to SSU and CSU.
- (7) Participate in outbreak investigations as member of Rapid Response Team
- (8) Implementation of Internal Quality Assurance of laboratories and ensure participation in External Quality Assurance Programme.
- (9) Assist in procurement of laboratory consumable items and maintenance of laboratory equipment including calibration of equipment like micropipettes.
- (10) Coordinate with medical college laboratories and private laboratories in the district participating in disease surveillance
- (11) Coordinate sample collection and transport of specimens from DPHL, Medical College Laboratories and Private Laboratories to State, Regional, National level laboratories.
- (12) Support district surveillance unit in other works related to effective implementation of IDSP
- (13) To carry out all IHIP-IDSP related activities in the District.
- (14) Any other work assigned by DSO.
