WHEREAS on his/her application, the Department of Health and Family Welfare/State Health Society/NHM-MP has selected the candidate for the programme conducted by the Madhya Pradesh Medical Science University, Jabalpur or IGNOU commencing from the _____ day of _____ 2021 and offered the candidate with sponsorship for undergoing the same vide letter of offer dated...../...../20.....

Now the condition of above written bond is,

1. That the candidate shall successfully complete his/her training programme of Certificate in Community Health (CCH)
2. The period of his/her training programme of Certificate in Community Health (CCH) shall be an integral part of bond.
3. That the candidate shall serve District Health Society-NHM, MP for a minimum period of 03 (three) years (herein after referred to as the “Bond Period”), after appointment as Community Health Officer (CHO) for 3 (three) years of contractual service at sub health centre (SHC) level Health and Wellness Centres (HWCs) determined by NHM-MP
4. That the candidate shall serve State Health Department /DHS/ NHM-MP for a minimum period of 3 (three) years till which the bond executed hereby shall remain valid in full force.
5. That the candidate shall be appointed as contractual intern CHO, till he/she successfully pass the final year examination of CCH conducted by IGNOU/MPMSU and provide the marksheet of the same to State Health Department/State Health Society/NHM, MP

6. The period of contractual appointment as Intern CHO shall be included within the bond period of 3 (three) years of contractual service at SHC level Health and Wellness Centres (HWCs) determined by NHM-MP.
7. That in the event candidate commits any breach of his/her undertakings under the bond or leaves/resigns after joining the training of CCH, or in case he/she fails to serve the State Health Department/State Health Society/NHM, Madhya Pradesh for the stipulated bond period thereafter he/she and/or his/her surety shall jointly and severally compensate the State Health Department/State Health Society. This amount shall be recovered from him/her and/or from his/her surety. The bond amount shall be recovered as per below,
 - 7.1 If candidate breach the conditions of bond as mentioned in the points under clause 4 of terms and conditions.
 - 7.2 If candidate resigns after appointment as Community Health Officer (CHO) for 03 (three) years of contractual service at SHC level Health and Wellness Centres (HWCs).
 - 7.3 If candidate breach the conditions of bond and resigns after beginning of training session/before completion of training session, then the candidate and/or his/her surety shall jointly and severally compensate the NHM, MP the amount of Rs. 1,00,000 (One Lakh) only.
 - 7.4 If candidate breach the conditions of bond and resigns after completion of training session and/or appointment as Intern CHO or contractual Community Health Officer (CHO) on contractual basis, before the stipulated minimum period of three (03) years, then the candidate and/or his/her surety shall jointly and severally compensate the NHM, MP the amount of Rs. 2,00,000 (Two Lakhs).

However, the total amount recoverable under these clauses shall not exceed Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs only).

That, the Candidate and Surety shall abide with the Terms & Conditions given ahead:

- 1. Certificate Programme:** - Candidate will undergo certificate course (Certificate in Community Health – CCH) offered through joint collaboration of NHM and IGNOU/MPMSU (hereinafter referred to as ‘Programme’), which is of six months’ duration. The candidate shall complete the programme successfully in all aspects within the stipulated six months’ period or within the extended period as per the norms.
- 2. Maximum Limit of Sponsorship:** - Candidates are provided support for operationalization cost of the course through IGNOU/MPMSU (covers registration, training material, contact theory & practical trainings, examinations, transportation/travel cost etc.) paid during the certificate course and expenses incurred by it on account of and in connection with his/her certificate programme as part of the sponsorship for this programme, as per applicable norms of Gol. However, this support will be provided only for one tenure. (i.e.; the period from commencement of the course till the final Terms End Examination conducted for the concerned batch by IGNOU/MPMSU for the first time.) No support shall be provided to the candidate for any successive attempts to successfully complete the programme.
- 3. No Permanent Absorption in the Department of Health & Family Welfare/NHM, MP**
 - 3.1 After completion of CCH training, the Candidate will be eligible for deployment as Intern CHO or contractual Community Health Officer (CHO) at SHC level Health & Wellness Centre (HWC) on the basis of choice filling for vacant SHCs and his/her rank in the entrance test subject to approval by NHM-MP
 - 3.2 The deployment of the Candidate as Intern CHO or CHO will be purely on contractual/conditional basis, and the Candidate will have no right to claim for regular/permanent appointment in Health Department/NHM MP or absorption after bond period.
 - 3.3 Contractual/Conditional placement and posting thereof to any SHC level Health & Wellness Centre within the District/State shall be at the discretion of the NHM-MP.
 - 3.4 Candidate, upon deployment as Intern CHO, will be paid Rs. 15000 (Fifteen thousand rupees only) per month as stipend per month.
 - 3.5 Candidate, upon deployment as contractual CHO, will be paid Rs. 25000 (Twenty-Five Thousand only) per month as honorarium and Rs 15000 (Fifteen thousand only) per month as Performance Based Incentive (PBI) for duration of his/her tenure as CHO.
- 4. Surety Bond for Service Delivery**

The Candidate and the surety shall sign and submit this “Surety Bond” in the prescribed format on Rs. 500/- Stamp Paper (non-judicial) for contractual appointment under the Department of Health & Family Welfare/NHM Madhya Pradesh to serve any SHC level Health & Wellness Centre of the Health Department for at least three (03) years after joining as CHO.

- 4.1 In case, the Candidate fails to serve the Department of Health/NHM Madhya Pradesh for the stipulated period of three years; thereafter, the Candidate and Candidate's Surety shall jointly and severally compensate the Department of Health/NHM MP as per bond.
- 4.2 This amount will be recovered from Candidate and/or his/her Surety, if candidate leaves the Department of Health & Family Welfare/NHM MP within the Bond period.
- 4.3 Further, the Candidate shall be required to serve one-month advance notice while on working as interns/contractual CHO, or pay salary (notice pay) in lieu thereof in addition to fulfilling the obligations stipulated in the Service Contract/Agreement Bond/Norms of the Department of Health & Family Welfare/NHM Madhya Pradesh.
- 4.4 Candidate shall not be relieved during the period of operation of Surety Bond for any employment elsewhere during the Service Contract/Agreement Bond period thereafter, without the prior permission of the NHM-MP.

5. Submission of Personal File for joining as CHO:

Along with acceptance of the offer, the Candidate is required to submit her/his complete following documents as per the list provided by NHM-MP to the O/o concerned Chief Medical and Health Officer (CMHO): -

- a) Application form result of Written Exam, letter of final selection and dates on which her/his name is existing.
- b) Grade card or Score card of CCH issued by IGNOU/MPMSU
- c) Attested copies of Mark-sheet and Certificate of relevant qualification as per eligibility criteria.
- d) Attested copy of proof of date of birth (10th/Madhyamik /Secondary Certificate)
- e) Copy of Surety Bond signed between NHM Madhya Pradesh and Candidate.
- f) Caste Certificate (If the candidate belongs to any Reserved Category).

6. General Conditions during Service Period:

- 6.1 Candidate will at all time be subject to the terms & conditions of his/her employment, including the Conduct, Discipline etc. and such other rules and administrative orders issued by GoI/DoH/NHM-MP that may be in force from time to time during job period.
- 6.2 Candidate's selection is subject to the condition that he/she is not suffering from any medical disability or illness, which is likely to hamper Candidate's contractual appointment at Sub Centre/Health & Wellness Centre. For this purpose, the candidate is required to submit her/his Medical Certificate at the time of final joining with O/o concerned Chief Medical and Health Officer. In case it is detected at a later stage that Candidate had concealed any information pertaining to Candidate's medical status, the Department of Health & Family Welfare/NHM Madhya Pradesh shall cancel the offer of selection. In case of such evidence coming to light after candidate's joining, Candidate's services (Contractual/ Conditional) will be liable for termination without notice at any

- time and Candidate will accordingly cease to be in the employment (Contractual/ Conditional) of the Department of Health & Family Welfare/NHM Madhya Pradesh.
- 6.3 Postings under the Department of Health & Family Welfare/NHM Madhya Pradesh are transferable to any district in state. The Department of Health & Family Welfare/NHM Madhya Pradesh reserves the right to post Candidate at any of its Sub Centre/Health & Wellness Centre within the District, if needed and not vice-versa means Candidate shall not demand any transfer on his/her own.
- 6.4 The offer of selection is liable to be withdrawn at any point before joining by the candidate and if joined, liable for termination without notice if NHM-MP comes across any evidence/knowledge that the qualification, caste/category and/or any other particulars provided by the candidate in his/her application/other forms/formats submitted to the NHM-MP are not accredited/false/misleading and/or amounts to suppression of information/particulars/facts, which should have been brought to the notice of NHM-MP.
- 6.5 Inadvertent omission or commission or mistakes, if any, appearing in the offer of selection issued by NHM-MP, are liable to be rectified at any time by NHM-MP before or after joining to bring the terms & conditions of offer in accordance with the extant policy/rules and regulation of the Department of Health & Family Welfare/NHM Madhya Pradesh that may be in force from time to time.
- 6.6 Above terms & conditions are not exhaustive and this offer is subject to understanding that during the period of training period/services (contractual/conditional), Candidate will be governed by the relevant rules, regulations and administrative orders that are framed from time to time by the Department of Health & Family Welfare/NHM Madhya Pradesh.
- 6.7 No extension in joining time will be granted and the candidate shall be expected to join on the scheduled date itself. If the candidate fails to join before scheduled date, the offer may be subject to cancellation and withdrawal without further notice to the Candidate. However, the Mission Director, NHM-MP may grant suitable extension in joining time on a case to case basis, in special circumstances only.
- 6.8 Candidate will honour and observe the Department of Health & Family Welfare/NHM Madhya Pradesh's vision, mission and values at all times to maintain high esteem of the Department of Health & Family Welfare/NHM Madhya Pradesh. Candidate is expected to provide all health services to the community through the Department of Public Health only.

7. Termination of Services by either Party:

- 7.1 The Department of Health & Family Welfare may terminate the contract at any time, if performance of the Candidate is not found satisfactory as per terms & conditions of the contract. In the event of such termination, Department of Health & Family Welfare/NHM-MP shall issue one-month non-performance notice and give reason

thereof, and if candidate does not reply within 7 days by ensuring improved services and does not give sufficient reasons for such non-performance, non-compliance, then the Contract shall be terminated as aforesaid.

7.2 If for reasons provided in writing, the candidate decides to terminate the Contract/Bond prior to joining as CHO and/or satisfactory completion of 3-year services, she/he may do so by giving one-month Notice to the Department of Health & Family Welfare. In this case also, the Candidate shall be liable to refund maximum of Rs. 1,20,000/- (One Lakh twenty thousand rupees only).
